##### Biographical/Administrative History

The item is undated. It was prepared to commemorate those who died in the Irish War of Independence and the subsequent Civil War. This may suggest it was prepared by or for republicans unsympathetic to the Anglo-Irish Treaty of December 1921, which led to a split in the Irish Republican Army and the Civil War.

## CONTENT AND STRUCTURE

### Scope and Content

Photocopy of handbill, 'Irish Republican Army Roll of Honour, West Cork's Heroic Dead'. Lists the deaths of about 50 IRA men from West Cork during the War of Independence and Civil War. Gives rank, name, address, date of death, place of death; such as "Vol. John Hurley, Moulagow, Drinagh: 1916. G.P.O. Dublin" and such as "Vice -Commdt. Michael McCarthy, East Green, Dunmanway: 28th November, 1920, Kilmichael" and such as "Capt. Timothy Kennefick, Fairhill, Cork: 11th December, 1922, Coachford".
