Fermoy Town Council (formerly Fermoy Urban District Council (1899-2001), and Fermoy Town Commissioners (1861-1899))

***Archival History***

These records were generated by the Town Council, in its earlier incarnations as Fermoy Town Commissioners and Fermoy Urban District Council, in the performance of its functions in the period concerned. Originally housed in Council offices at the Courthouse, Fermoy, the records were at some point moved for storage to the waterworks facilities at Straw Hall and Coolroe. They were identified as archives during CCCA's Archives Action Plan Survey 2005, and transferred to CCCA in January and April 2007.

***Administrative History***

Fermoy Urban District Council was created in 1899, as a successor body to Fermoy Town Commissioners. It became Fermoy Town Council in 2001 under the Local Government Act of that year. The Town Council has responsibilities in respect of housing, water and sanitary services, roads maintenance, and some planning functions. In the past it has performed public health functions in connection with the Boards of Health and Public Assistance. It is closely associated with Cork County Council. The Town Council itself is an elected body. It employs a number of officers and staff, including the Town Manager (who exercises some executive powers), the Town Clerk, and the Water Curator.

## Content and Structure

### Scope and Content

The records of Fermoy Town Council consist of a wide range of material, covering the meetings of elected town commissioners and councillors, the administration of the Town Clerk, and the actions of the Council's officers. They also document the collection of poor rates, the discharge of sanitary, health, and licensing functions, and major developments, such as the Fermoy Gas Bill, 1909.
